Historic City Market - Berkley Riverfront Park, Kansas City, Missouri www.thecitymarketkc.org

The area centers on City Market, dating to 1857, where casual global eateries, gourmet grocery stores and indie boutiques surround pavilions hosting a weekend farmers' market. The city market is home to the Arabia Steamboat Museum which displays paraphernalia salvaged from a ship that sunk in the Missouri River in the mid-19th century. Broad paths for strolling and biking trace the shoreline in Berkley Riverfront Park. CPKC Stadium is a soccer-specific stadium being built in Kansas City, Missouri, for the Kansas City Current of the National Women's Soccer League, who currently play home games at Children's Mercy Park. The stadium is scheduled to be completed and opened by March 2024.

Over 100 years of iconic history can be found at Kansas City's Union Station. Opened in 1914, Union Station, continues to service Amtrak train routes. There are several excellent restaurants in the station, a planetarium, Science City, a movie Theatre, and many other attractions. Parking on site (for a fee), streetcar access right in front of station. There are other places on the streetcar route with free parking.

National WW I Museum and Memorial, Memorial Drive, KC, MO 64108 www.theworldwar.org

The National WWI Museum and Memorial is the only American museum solely dedicated to preserving the objects, history and personal experiences of a war whose impact still echoes in the world today. Designated by Congress as America's official World War I Museum and located in downtown Kansas City, MO, the National WWI Museum and Memorial inspires thought, dialogue and learning to make the experiences of the Great War era meaningful and relevant for present and future generations.
